- 2) The man in the parable traveled between which two cities?
- 3) What happened to the man in the parable as he was traveling?
- 4) Two important religious men passed by the man lying on the side of the road. Neither of them stopped to help him. Who were they?
- 5) A Samaritan man passed by and stopped to help the man. He bandaged his wounds, and where did he take the man?
- 6) The people listening to Jesus were surprised that the man who helped was a Samaritan. Why?
- 7) When Jesus finished telling the story, what was His final instruction to the lawyer who asked the question?
- 8) CHALLENGE: The Samaritan took the man to the inn and left the innkeeper with something. What was it?
