For this edition of the Harmony Corner Challenge, let's test your knowledge on the story of Ruth and Naomi in the book of Ruth! Answer the questions that Pastor Peabody asks our friends in Discovery Mountain.

- 1) Elimelech and Naomi left Judah to live in Moab. Why did they leave their homeland?
- 2) What were the names of Naomi's two sons?
- 3) Ruth married one son. Who married the other?
- 4) Sadly, Naomi's husband and both of her sons died. She decided to return to Judah. What did Ruth and Orpah do?
- 5) What did Ruth do to find food for her and Naomi?
- 6) The owner of the field, Boaz, was kind to Ruth. How did he show his kindness?
- 7) Boaz was a relative of Naomi's late husband. He and Ruth decided to get married, but there was one problem. What was it?
- 8) Ruth and Boaz had a baby son. What was his name?
- 9) CHALLENGE: When Boaz spoke to the closer relative about marrying Ruth, they came to an agreement. What did the closer relative hand to him to show he could marry Ruth?



(1) There was a famine (2) Chilion and Mahlon (3) Orpah (4) Ruth went with Naomi, and Orpah stayed in Moab and went back to her family (Ruth famously said to Naomi, "For wherever you go, I will go, and wherever you lodge, I will lodge. Your people shall be my people, and your God, my God") (5) Gleaned in a barley field (6) He told the workers to be kind to her and leave some of the barley for her to pick up (7) There was a closer relative whom Boaz had to ask to give up his right to marry Ruth first (8) Obed (9) His sandal (or shoe)
